#### **GSLF Moves Ahead In Geneva Addressing the UNHRC to Separate the Truth from the Fabrications**

The Global Sri Lankan Forum – Executive Committee , GSLF-Ex. Comm. will be involved in a number of exercises in the 40<sup>th</sup> UNHRC sessions on Geneva, especially to educate and create awareness of the questionable UNHRC Resolution 30/1 which is being widely used as a whipping tool by the so called human rights defenders and politicians who play geopolitics.

The GSLF-Ex. Comm. will challenge the legality as well as the credibility of the UNHRC resolution 30/1 which alleged wild allegations on the defense service personnel of Sri Lanka.

The GSLF-Ex. Comm. will also expose the Yesmin Sooka who pulled the wool over the unsuspecting UN members by concocting with allegations of human rights violations by Sri Lankan forces while Sooka being treated right royally by the LTTE Tamil terrorists' fronts.

The GSLF will also focus on the recruitment and abuse of child soldiers by the LTTE and leading perpetrators of waging war with the children such as Adela Balasingham.

Among the other areas which are going to be spotlighted by the GSLF- Ex. Comm., in the 40<sup>th</sup> UNHRC Session in Geneva from 25<sup>th</sup> Feb. to 20<sup>th</sup> March 2019 are a panel discussion under the theme of *“Terrorism, Counter Terrorism and Human Rights in*

*Sri Lankan Context*” and defending the rights of the defense personnel in defending the civilians and property of the country from Tamil terrorist attacks.

The GSLF-Ex. Comm. will also hold an exhibition on 8th March 2019 in front of the UNHRC building on the subject of *'No War Crimes, No Genocide but Peace in Sri Lanka'* and a protest rally on the unjustified allegations and fabricated crimes 'attributed' to Sri Lankan defence forces opposite the Geneva Lake along with other patriotic Sri Lankan organizations.


The Event Calendar of the GSLF-Ex. Comm. for the 40<sup>th</sup> UNHRC session is as follows:
